




Figure: Emissions of companies by emission level

Companies conducted GHG inventories




Companies with GHG mitigation plans



Already have a GHG mitigation plan


Companies' understanding of ETS and the carbon market




Do not understand how the ETS and carbon market work

- Clearly understand how the ETS and carbon market works, their differences, their interactions and roles in the CTX


Overall readiness level of companies in the survey regarding participation in the ETS




Readiness level of companies categorized by sector
